Over the last seven days 576 people from 23 states worked together to clear an estimated 284, 770 invasive cedar trees from over 100 acres of dolomite glade. The estimated monetary value of this work is approximately \$542,260 however the value of saving these glades for future generations is priceless. Jenny Farenbaugh of the US Forest Service had this to say about the project, "This has been a remarkable team effort between the Arrowman who have come from all over the United States and the forest service employees to make this a successful conservation project".
